<u>About Scandinavia:</u> Sweden, Denmark Iceland and Finland are beautiful countries. Encourage your children to do some research about these countries. The weather in summer is pleasant (similar to San Francisco). You will not need heavy jackets. Most people in Scandinavia speak several languages including English. Local players love to make friends with teenagers from the NSA. The ice cream is great!

The TOUR:

June 30, 2013 (Sunday) Depart Gateway City (Seattle, Denver)

July 1 – Iceland sightseeing tour

July 2 – 6 Intense training in Denmark or Sweden

July 7-13 – Cup No 1 in Denmark; July 14-20 Gothia Cup; July 21, 2013 (Sunday) return to USA.

Cost of Tour (subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances)

- Land portion 3 weeks, including most lodging**, food**, training, coaches, administrators, compete in two major international tournaments.: \$3000.00
- Travel from USA to Scandinavia, ferry and land travel \$2000.00

 Travel from your home town to the gateway airport for Scandinavia will be paid by participants. Gateway from USA to Scandinavia (Seattle, Denver, Minneapolis St Paul, New York, Boston, Washington).
- NSA Uniforms Package \$300.00
- Please budget an additional \$400 to \$600- for misc expenditures and player spending money.

The following are additional expenses:

- During the intense training week, lodging and food will be additional. Coach Brad and Coach Kevin are excellent chefs and will prepare healthy meals for the players at the club house. Lodging and cost and food will depend on where we end up staying. (approx \$150 to 200- for the week)
- All meals not provided by the tournament will be paid for by the participants.

 Although players are provided with lodging and meals supplied by the Tournament, some players may miss meals (e.g. they choose to, game schedule etc.).
- Players must provide their own spending money. Visits to amusement parks, other sightseeing trips, meals during the travel between cities and purchasing souvenirs for parents etc..

SUPPORTERS:

Supporters are welcome. We encourage families to come join the fun. NSA will arrange for supporters to stay in hotels and travel with the group (e.g. airplane, buses and ferries between cities).

The NSA schedule of events are based heavily on the game schedule (which changes based on results). Based on past experience, it is much better to supporters to travel with NSA.

Due to our relationships with the airlines, supporters may have different travel dates than the main group and still be included in the NSA block of tickets.

Supporters who have other means to arrange for flights (e.g. airline miles) should let us know as soon as possible so we do not reserved an airline seat for you. Cost of airfare will be deducted from total cost.

Please read the sheet title "Helpful hints for NSA supporters". Cost for supporters packages is similar to the players but may vary depending on your itinerary and type of accommodations. Please contact Fred immediately if you plan to travel with the group.

Supporters should follow the payment schedule as listed above except the 4th payment will be adjusted to the actual balance.

Passports and Visas:

A valid passport is required. <u>You must apply immediately if you do not have one</u>. Visas may be required if you do not have an American passport. (check with the Swedish consulate).

Refunds:

To enable a successful tour, we must have serious players with families wishing to make a major commitment. The initial \$300.00 deposit is non-refundable.

Refunds (minus a \$750.00 processing fee) will be entertained up to 2/15/2013.

After 2/16//2013, there will be no refunds.

Please bear in mind that much of the tour cost has to be pre-paid.

Medical:

If you are less than 100% physically fit prior to departure for the trip, it is your responsibility to contact NSA prior to leaving home. Any decision on your travel must be made after consultation with the NSA Director. A health statement/evaluation form is also required for each player.

Equipment:

You are responsible for all soccer equipment including shoes. Remember to bring along any additional items that you normally use for training or games, such as tape, water bottle, shin guards etc.. A suggested packing list is enclosed.

Accommodations:

Accommodations will be in classrooms provided by the tournaments. All players must bring their own sleeping bag and air mattress.

Meals:

Fees include meal tickets purchased from each tournament. <u>Meals not covered by the tournament will be paid for by players (e.g. meals during travel days).</u>

Money Exchange - important factors to know about conversion

An ATM DEBIT card from a CHECKING ACCOUNT is the best way to handle money. During your trip you will use three different currencies. Please make sure your ATM DEBIT card from your checking account works before you leave the USA and don't forget your pin number.

Traveler's checks are not convenient and more costly.

If players bring only U.S. Dollars, it will still need to be exchanged. They also run the risk of losing it. There is a commission every time an exchange is made to local currency.

There are many details that need to be planned in order for this tour to be successful. It is crucial that you follow our schedule. Please communicate openly and in a timely manner with us if you have any questions.

The following is a list of rules and regulations that will be enforced by the director, administrators and coaches of the National Soccer Academy. All players who participate in NSA events and tours are subject to these rules. This document requires signatures from the player and parent/guardian(s). Please read, sign, and return the original.		
1. Possession by any player of pocket knives, guns, fire-crackers, firearms, alcoholic beverages, drugs (unprescribed or illegal), other weapons, or related paraphenalia will result in immediate expulsion from the National Soccer Academy event/tour.		
2. Unauthorized visits to rooms/houses by members of the opposite sex, incidents of stealing or vandalism, unauthorized absences from any practice, game or group function, or failure to inform officials of your destination, may result in disciplinary action and/or expulsion from the event/tour.		
3. Players must always be in the presence of staff personnel or assigned chaperones, unless specific approval is obtained. While on tour the curfew for players shall be 9:00 p.m. Quiet time will be designated until the mandatory lights out time (between 10:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.).		
4. Any action which could threaten the health and safety of individuals or group members, may result in immediate expulsion.		
5. Arrest and detention by a government official (local or foreign) will result in immediate expulsion from NSA. Parent(s)/Guardian(s) assume immediate responsibility should a player be detained by a government official for any reason.		
6. When necessary, searches of rooms and belongings may be carried out by tour officials. In most cases, players will have the opportunity, without penalty, to turn in any incriminating items before the search.		
7. Repeated minor violations (such as disrespect for coaches, staff, players, use of tobacco, cigarette lighters, toy guns and water pistols, or profanity) may also result in expulsion.

NSA rule: no eating candy except on Saturdays Helpful Hints for NSA Supporters

NSA players travel as a 'tight' family. Players are managed by the tour leader, the coaches and administrators. Soccer is the focus of the player group.

Parents and other supporters are welcome to watch the matches. Supporters' group focus may be watching the games, sightseeing, touring or any combination - independent of the players group.

Supporters will have their air travel, land travel between tournaments to their hotels arranged. Breakfasts are included with the hotel. Once they arrive at the hotels, supporters are on their own. Match schedules will be provided when possible. An itinerary of the players and supporters will also be provided.

Following are some hints: On the Field:

- Enjoy the matches, video tape them, take lots of pictures, enjoy the atmosphere, cheer for the team, make friends with people from around the world. Leave your children and other players alone so that they grow from their experience.
- Never tell an NSA coach how to coach, NSA staff are professional coaches - trust their instincts and experience regarding the game of soccer. Look to the "process" of development (the big picture) for achievements, not simply the scores of the matches or the amount of time your child is present on the field. Judging from the players who have trained and traveled with NSA, the NSA coaches have been very successful in treading the fine line of helping a child develop the "performance" part of their game without undue pressure during these tours. NSA does not and will not condone the "win at all cost" mentality. However, do not send your child with us if you cannot accept the coaches decisions as to who represents NSA during matches.
- "Performance" is emphasized during these tours -- not the amount of time a player is present on the field during matches. NSA staff coaches will do what is best for the teams to enhance "performance".
- During tournament competition, the best players at that time will represent NSA on the field. Substitutions will be made due to
 - a) injury;
 - b) player's performance;
 - c) tactical changes for the match;
 - d) scores are lop sided.
- There is absolutely no guarantee on the amount of "match" time for any player. To

increase the amount of possible "match" time of all our players, NSA tries to enter extra teams so some players may play on more than one team. Parents of players participating on the tour must accept the NSA coaches judgment regarding who represents NSA at the matches.

Off the field:

- Sightsee with friends and other supporters. Relax and have a fun time. Leave your children with the NSA staff so they become independent and enjoy the soccer tour atmosphere.
- offer to help with laundry. That has always been a big job.
- All players must stay with the tour. You child must never be isolated from the other players (unless he/she is sick).

Supporters are not allowed to take their children away from the group without prior approval from the tour leader. Should the opportunity arise, you may take your child for a brief period of time. However, your child must invite at least three other players and go with you as a group.

A Good NSA tour supporter

- does not have unrealistic ideas about their child's ability.
- is very flexible. Traveling on soccer tours can be very stressful to some.
- does not have unrealistic expectations from the tour.
- does not "cling" to your children during the tour

Introduction: Fundraising can make a substantial impact on players' costs. Many players have been able to defray the majority of the tour fees by attracting local sponsors. However, hard work is needed. Amateur players at all levels, youth through senior, know that funding for training and competitions comes only from a well thought out plan.

Ideas:

- 1) Compose a **nice letter** and mail to friends, relatives, family doctor, dentist, your parents, co-workers and anyone else who may support you. The letter should be concise, talk about yourself, your goals, the Eurotour and end with asking for sponsorship. It is also a good idea to include a copy of a recent soccer picture with the letter. You maybe surprised at how many people will support you in this great adventure.
- 2) NSA **yearbook**: Similar to most tournament brochures, participants may sell advertisements in the NSA yearbook. 75% of the income from the advertisements will be credited towards your tour cost. Advertisements are tax deductible for most companies.
- 3) Work with friends from you area to arrange fund raising events.

Based on our past experiences and the suggestions of some professional fundraisers, the following general guidelines should be followed:

- 1. Be as organized and professional as possible. Take the necessary materials with you as in forms, letters of introduction and brochures.
- 2. Be polite, positive and patient. Dress neatly.
- 3. Meet prospective donors face-to-face. Personal contact is the best way to show that you are interested in the donor. Phone calls (not too many) are also good.
- 4. Follow up meetings with a thank you letter and any materials requested by the donor. Do not wait until tomorrow. Donors will feel your enthusiasm and respond.
- 5. Do not always look for the big, donor. Expect most to give between \$25 and \$50.
- 6. Start early. Plan a list of family, friends, relatives, local businesses and others. The more local, the better. Think of places where you shop.
- 7. The more sponsors, the more support you have. Suppose you set a goal of \$1200. Make yourself a tree of gifts and fill it in:

- 8. If possible, try to find an adult who would be willing to serve as the guide for your fundraising efforts by giving advise, connections and support.' You do the legwork.
- 9. Keep you sponsors informed from abroad. Budget a postcard or two for each.

Be creative and honest. Deliver value.
